

Volo's Gamepad to PS/2 Adapter Instruction Manual

Volo's Gamepad to PS/2 Adapter is designed to add signals from gamepads into keyboard connection allowing you to play games designed for keyboards using gamepads and joysticks.

1. Volo's Gamepad to PS/2 Adapter may be used, when connected as follows:



Gamepad + keyboard
through PS/2



Gamepad + keyboard
through USB



Laptop + gamepad
(device acts as keyboard)



Any PS/2 or USB
keyboard host.

2. Volo's Gamepad to PS/2 Adapter connections:



PS/2 PC connector
(through included
PS/2 or AT cable)

connect to a
modern PC



PS/2 Socket to
connect real
keyboard

3. Supported gamepads and joysticks:

4. Default button assignment

Only default button configuration is set from the box (i.e. preset #0).

The configuration the device acquires when booted:



You may not normally change the default setting permanently, so feel free to alter the default setting for temporary configuration (i.e. for games you play only once).

5. Accessing alternative button assignment presets

For more permanent games (or for playing on a laptop) there are 6 additional presets you may assign (or reassign) permanently. Presets #1-6 are saved even when powered off.



Please note that Presets #1-6 are not set out of the box, so don't be surprised that when changing Presets, gamepads stop working – it is just gamepad buttons need assigning.

6. Assigning buttons

You may assign keyboard buttons to gamepad keys using the following procedure:



7. How to change default (i.e. preset #0) key assignment permanently

To avoid wearing out EEPROM, the default button assignment (i.e. preset #0) is deliberately made hard to set permanently. If you absolutely need to change the default key setting permanently, save preset #0 by pressing and holding ~ (button to the left of "1") and pressing Scroll Lock.

8. WARNING:



1. Do not connect two computers through PS/2 and USB at once!
2. Do not plug in devices consuming more than 170 mA total! (200 mA including Volo's Gamepad to PS/2 Adapter)
